The registration books shall be opened for a period beginning on the thirtieth day after an election and closing on the fiftieth day before the date of the next election , and the place of registration shall be the business office of the district. The registration books shall include the full name and sex of the registrant, and the certificate of the registrant that he is a qualified elector of the district as provided by section 48-2917.	E
