Baseline Conditions Purpose

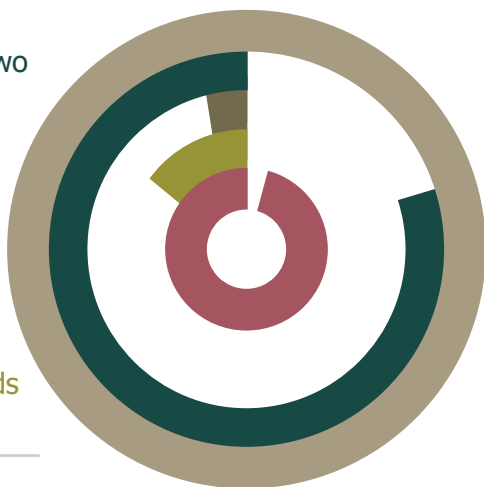
The purpose of Baseline Conditions is to establish an understanding of the transportation system in order to identify transportation needs that could be addressed by TSP 2040. Baseline Conditions provides an overview of the existing transportation network in Maricopa County including roadway characteristics, asset conditions, ITS infrastructure, and active transportation facilities. The review of baseline conditions also included an assessment of socioeconomic information, demographics, and land use and ownership and their potential impacts on traffic volumes and patterns.

80% are two lane roads

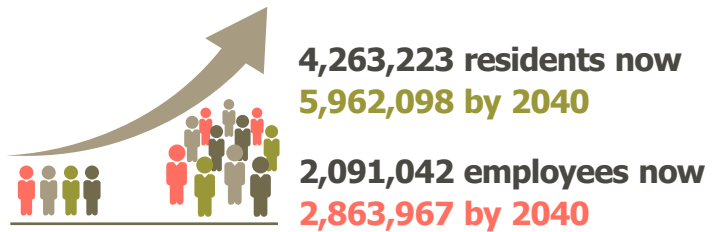
5% are three to six lane roads
