#### **Reasons for Permit Suspension**

The Maricopa County Environmental Services Department's standard operating procedures have outlined several reasons that a food establishments operating permit may be suspended. It is the responsibility of the PIC (Person-in-charge) to take the appropriate actions by ceasing operations and notifying the Department for guidance if necessary. ### **Permit Suspension Reasons**

Failure to correct the following violations at the time of inspection may result in suspension of the permit:

- Sewage backing up at a permitted establishment and/or the inability to retain or properly dispose of sewage relating to Mobile Food Establishments. (Note: Permit suspension is appropriate if sewage is backing up inside and/or outside an establishment.)
- Extended interruption (greater than one hour) of electrical service.
- No water service available.
- Food employees are unable to wash their hands due to inoperative, or absence of, hand washing facilities.
- Inability to maintain Time/Temperature Control for Safety Food (TCS) at proper temperatures.
- Flood.
- Fire or activation of a fire suppression system.
- Misuse of poisonous or toxic materials in such a manner that result in the direct contamination of food and/or food contact surfaces. (Example: The establishment operates a fumigation device to rid themselves of vermin while food and/or food contact surfaces are exposed.).
- Onset of an apparent foodborne illness or outbreak.
- Other gross insanitary occurrences, conditions, or other circumstances that may endanger public health, as approved by the Division Manager or designee.
