Note: Barking dog issues are handled independently by each city or town based on their local laws so you may notice varying enforcement procedures between cities and the county.

If you have a barking dog issue in an unincorporated area, you may call Maricopa County Animal Care and Control (MCACC) and include the address of the dog(s), your full name, address and telephone number to file a complaint. Please note that anonymous calls are not accepted.

Excessive barking may be a violation of the Regulation of Barking Dogs Ordinance if the noise disturbance is heard from within the closed confines of your house. The responding MCACC Field Division Staff will contact the complainant to discuss the issue and attempt to contact the dog owner (if known). The goal is to provide education and encourage both parties to work together to resolve the issue.

What You Can Do as the Complainant

- Speak to your neighbor—they might not be aware of the extent of their dog(s) barking and how it affects others
- Be sure the dog barking can be heard from inside your home
- Call MCACC to report a barking dog complaint; be specific (include when, how often, etc.)
- Obtain audio and/or video recordings of the excessive dog barking violations (from inside your home)

What You Can Do as the Dog Owner

- Try to determine when and why your dog(s) barks excessively
- Provide distractions for your dog: toys, sound from the radio/tv, etc.
- Bring your dog(s) inside when you are not at home
- Be responsive to quickly address the barking when you are home
- Provide daily exercise a tired dog is a quiet dog
- Train your dog, either on your own or with the help of a professional
- Speak to your neighbor(s) they may be able to help you identify when and why your dog is barking so that you can more quickly address the issue

BARKING DOG COMPLAINT PROCESS

Initial complaint received by MCACC Call Center. Case is opened and Dispatch notifies the Field Division Staff.

Field Staff contacts complainant within 72 hours to explain process and answer any questions. Field Staff attempts
to contact dog
owner (if known) to
explain laws and
provide solutions.
May send notice
letter if unable to
contact.

Additional complaints will result in letters being sent to the dog owner. No enforcement fines or penalties can be imposed via the ordinance.
