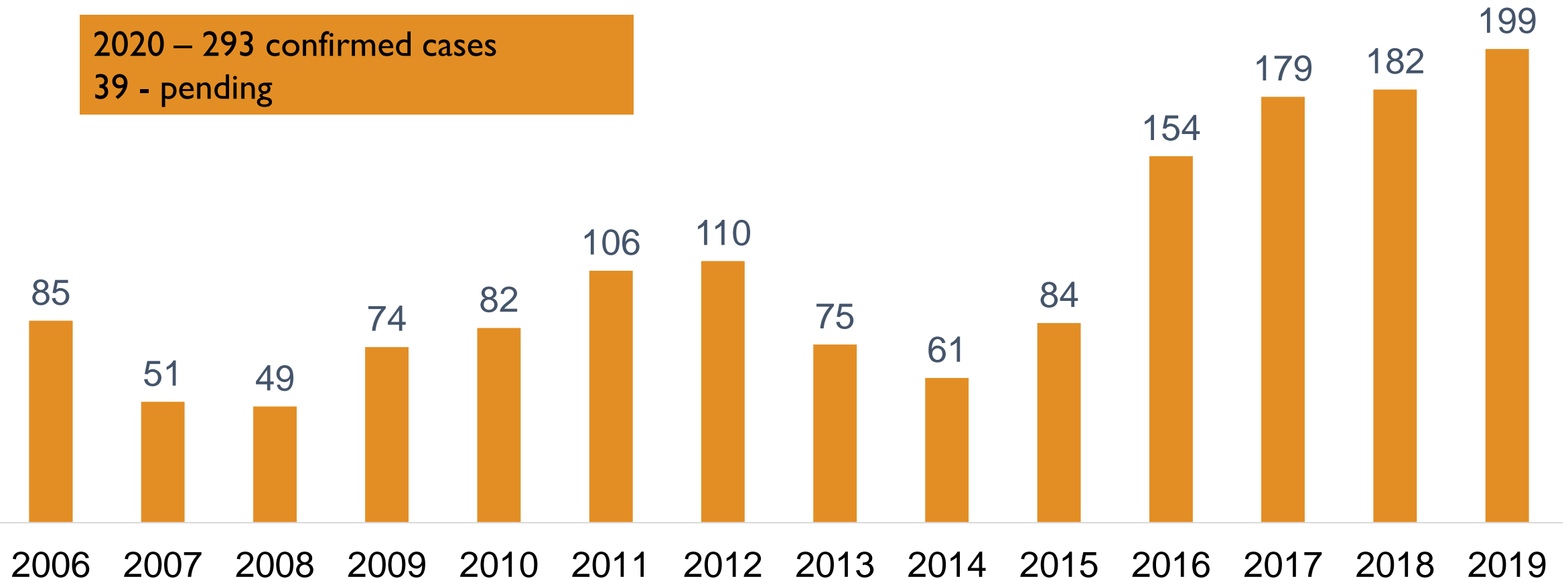


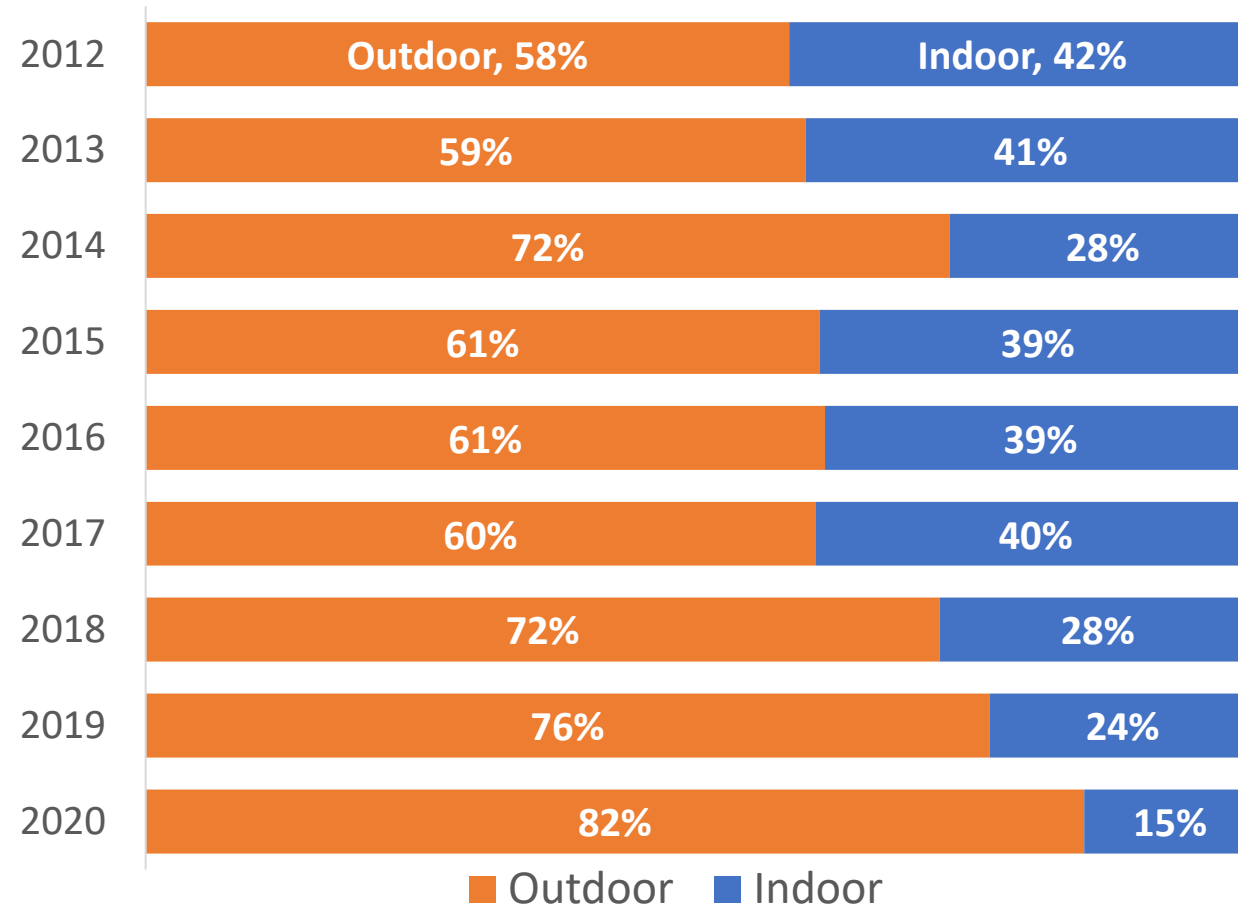
# Maricopa County had 1,491 heat-associated deaths from 2006 - 2019

39 - pending

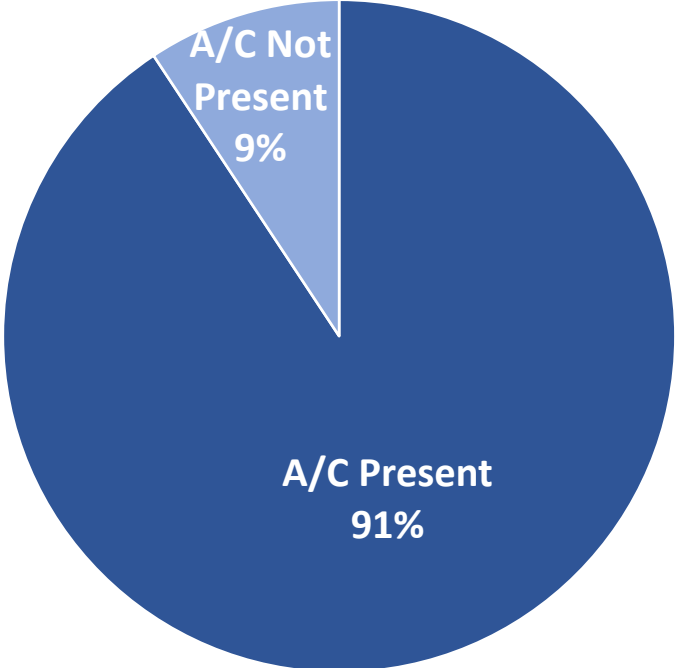


# Indoor and Outdoor Heat Deaths

---

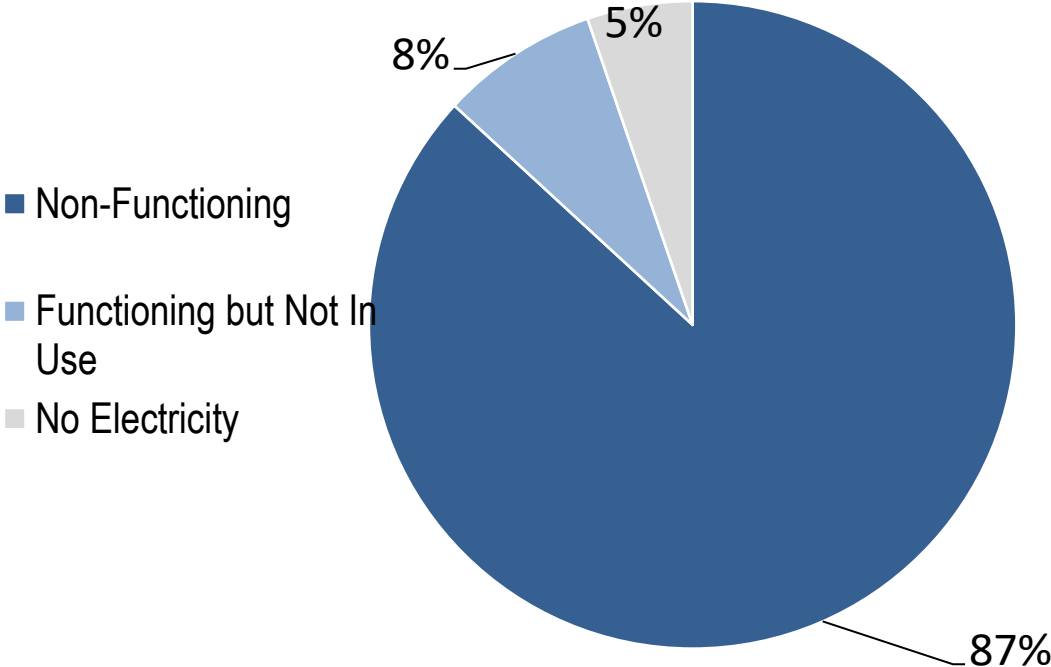


Ninety-one percent of indoor deaths had an air conditioning unit present at time of death. (N=43)

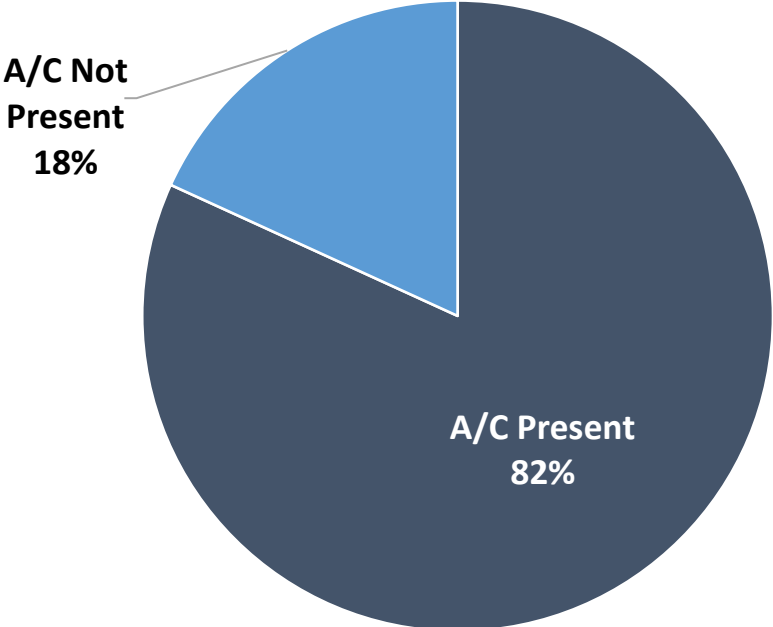


### AC Status of 2019 Heat Deaths

Among deaths where an A/C unit was present, a non-functioning A/C unit was the most common reason for not having a cooled environment at the time of death.

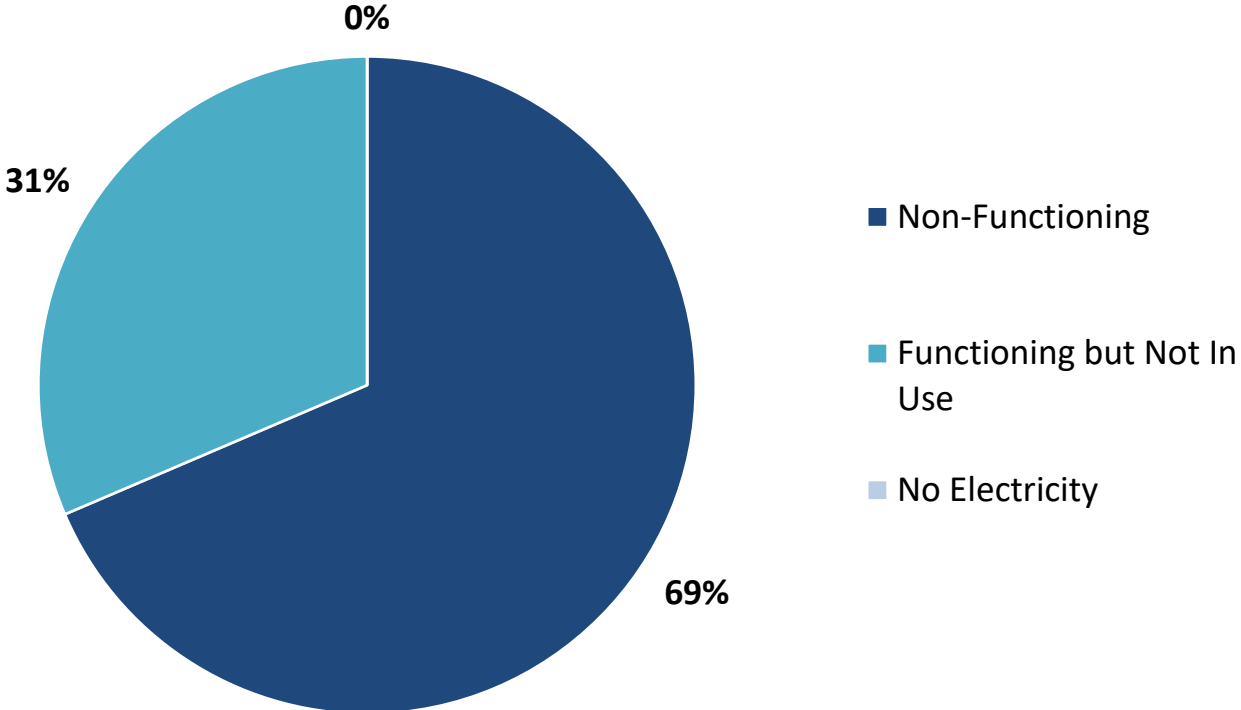


Eighty-two percent of indoor deaths had an air conditioning unit present at time of death. (N=45)

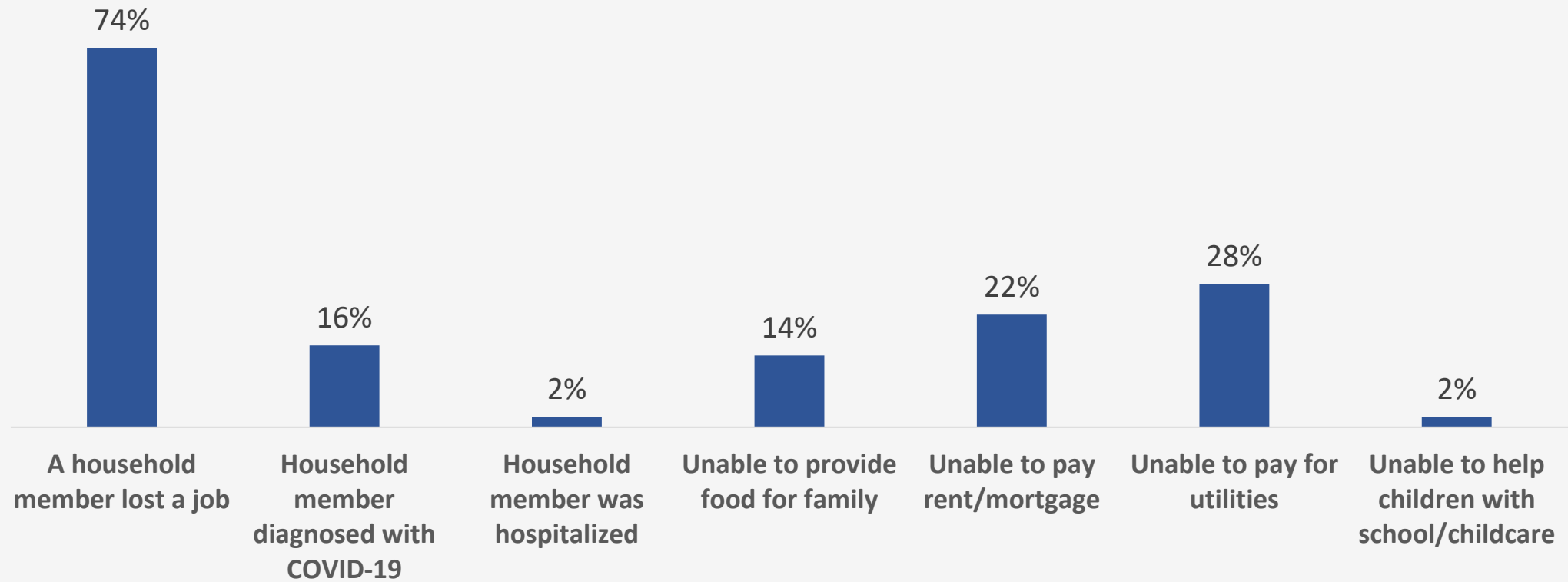

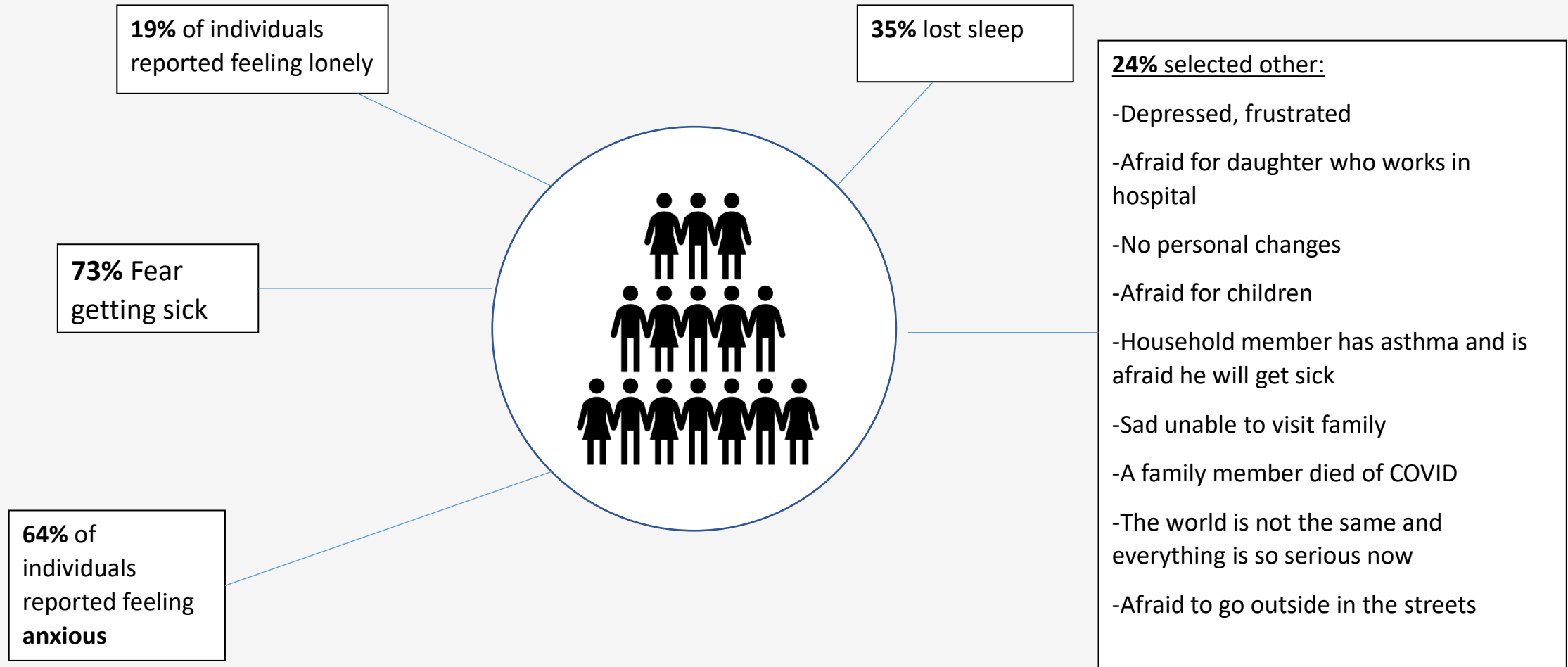
