Market Range Title Description

Positions in this market range title are responsible for providing inspections of sources to determine compliance with air quality laws, rules and regulations. Primary responsibilities include: inspecting and investigating dust sources, industrial and commercial air pollution sources and related control equipment; conducting routine unscheduled and citizen complaint investigations; evaluating inspection data to determine compliance status of facilities/sites; preparing and issuing enforcement documents for referral to the Enforcement Division; advising and educating the public and industry about environmental air quality issues, regulations, safety, policy and compliance and may be called upon to act as expert witness in legal proceedings.

Likely Minimum Qualifications

- Other combinations of education and experience may be considered in substitution for the minimum qualifications.
- Bachelor's degree with at least 30 semester hours of coursework in natural or physical science.
- Certified as a Visible Emissions Evaluator by the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality within 6 months of hire date.

Glossary:

Market Range Title: Broad grouping of related positions with like job responsibilities and qualifications. Market Range Titles typically include positions ranging from entry level to senior/lead level unless indicated otherwise.

Effective date: The date the salary range was implemented for use.

Market Range Title Description: Broad description of sample job duties and responsibilities of positions included in the Market Range Title. Each position included in a Market Range Title also has a job description that is specific to the department. Departments are responsible for writing and maintaining job descriptions for positions in their department. Employee Compensation is responsible for writing and maintaining Market Range Title Descriptions.

Likely Minimum Qualifications: Typical minimum qualifications for positions assigned to the Market Range Title. Because a broad group of jobs in different departments are included in a Market Range Title, minimum and preferred qualifications may vary slightly depending on the area of assignment.

Market Range: The minimum, midpoint, and maximum salary points for all positions included in the Market Range Title.

Hiring Range: The hiring range for all positions is ordinarily the minimum of the market range to the midpoint. The use of a different hiring range must be approved by Employee Compensation. Departments should use a hiring range that is within their funding capabilities and are required to comply with the County's Funded Position Policy ensuring that applicants are extended a rate that is supported by the department's budget.

Working Title: The specific title used by a department to identify a position within their organizational structure. Use of working titles is flexible and aimed to assist departments in identifying the unique functions and responsibilities of each position and is representative of the assigned Market Range Title. Ordinarily, supervisory and/or managerial titles should not be used for positions not assigned to a supervisory and/or manager Market Range Title.
